Study Trips and online learning

Participate in study trips to discover sites of importance during the Holocaust. A preparatory seminar, an 8-day study visit to Poland (July 29 – August 4, 2024), as well as shorter visits including to Mauthausen, Obersalzberg and Jewish Vienna.

Additionally, participants gain access to webinars exploring the experience of women in the Holocaust, the Roma genocide, Holocaust denial and distortion and more.



Survivor Meetings & Trainings

80 years after the Holocaust the number of survivors still alive, and able to share their first-hand testimony is dwindling. Participants have the unique opportunity to meet, in small groups with survivors, and become part of preserving their memory. Become an ambassador of remembrance: Receive training on memorialization, and share survivors' stories on social media, following the exclusive meetings.
