

**The criteria of enrollment to the Doctoral School in the Humanities  
as a PhD candidate in the NCN SONATA BIS 10 project  
“Travel and Mobility in Hellenistic and Early Roman Palestine”  
(PI: dr hab. Michał Wiktor Marciak)**

1. The enrollment follows the usual criteria established by the appropriate ruling of the Senate of the Jagiellonian University (29/01/2020).

2. Additional criteria of enrollment for the position in the project:

- candidate will be required to have an MA in a field relevant to the project (e.g., history, theology, philology, or cultural studies) effective on March 1, 2022;
- Candidate should have a competence in Biblical Greek or Hebrew, the knowledge of Greek is given priority, if the successful candidate does not have any knowledge of one of the required languages, he/she will be required to undergo intensive training during the first two years of the studies. The PhD student will also be expected to learn Biblical Aramaic during the PhD studies.
- Candidate should have a good knowledge of English;
- topic of the planned PhD should be strictly connected to research tasks of the project nos. 1, 3 and 5: study of the Septuagint with regard to travel and mobility;
- results of the candidate’s participation in the project should be prepared as a monograph to be published in an internationally recognized publishing house
- candidate should declare his ability to take part in research tasks of the project nos. 2, 4 and 6 (one-month research visits abroad);
- candidate should declare his ability to take part in research tasks of the project nos. 17, 21, 23, 25 and 27 (one-month fieldwork in Israel, Palestinian Authorities, and Jordan);
- candidate should declare his ability to take part in research tasks of the project no. 32 (international workshop at the Jagiellonian University) and no. 33 (synthesis of the project)
